Part B. FREE SUMMARY OF THE CURRICULUM

Teaching and research career: I have a degree and PhD in Philosophy from the Complutense University and a Diploma in Constitutional Law and Political Science from the Center for Political and Constitutional Studies. Previously I was Professor of Sociology at the Public University of Navarra (1991-1994). I have been visiting professor and guest researcher at several European, Latin American and North American universities: Free University of Berlin (Germany, 1985-86), McGill University (Canada, 1992), Harvard University (USA, 1997), University of British Columbia (Canada, 2003-2004), University of Victoria (Canada, 2011-12), Universidad Autónoma Metropolitana (Mexico, 1993, 1998, 2001), UNAM (Mexico, 2016), Escuela Nacional de Antropología e Historia (Mexico, 2006), Universidad de Chile (1997, 2000), Universidad Pontificia Bolivariana (Colombia, 2000), Universidad de Cali (Colombia, 2002), Universidad Nacional de Colombia (2002, 2004, 2014), UNISINOS (Brazil, 2003), Universidade Federal de Juiz de Fora (Brazil, 2009), Universidad de Costa Rica (2008, 2010) and Universidade do Minho (Portugal, 2014).

My research has focused mainly on the relationship between culture, collective identities and social change and the normative conflicts that result. From this perspective I have studied the political management of cultural diversity, as well as the historical dynamics of nationalism and religious affiliations. In recent years I added a spatial twist to this type of analysis, focusing on the materialisation of such issues in urban contexts.

To date, I have participated in 23 research projects (13 national, 7 bilateral and 3 European), of which I have directed or co-directed 14, and I have coordinated work packages in two European projects (RECODE, from the European Science Foundation and UNREST, from the



European Commission's H2020 Program). I am the author of 103 articles and book chapters, editor or co-editor of 17 collective volumes and author of 4 individual books.
